Annual Members Meeting  
Oct. 8, 2009

The meeting was called to order by Hank Hoover. Since Jerry Westling, our scheduled speaker, was absent we proceeded with the regular meeting.

The minutes of the Sept. 10 Board Meeting were approved as published on the web site. The Treasurer's Report was given by Nancy Reinhardt and approved.

Other discussions included Sterling Ranch which is slated for final plat approval on Oct. 20. It was announced that Meridian Ranch is giving the county a substantial amount of property for a park on Eastonville Road south of Latigo Blvd.

Hank announced that BFTA meetings are held on odd numbered months on the second Thursday at the Black Forest Community Center. It was decided to wait until Jan. 2010 to hold the next meeting.

After a drawing for door prizes, the meeting was adjourned and those present enjoyed refreshments and saw a demonstration of the BFTA web site.
