Meeting Minutes

- Steve presented minutes from the November 13, 2019 meeting. Motion by Barb to accept. Seconded by Andy and approved by unanimous voice vote.

Old Business

- Winter Newsletter – Andy Meng
 - **ACTION: (all authors) Articles due to Andy by 30 January.**

- Red Tail Ranch – Larry Fariss
 - Lots are being sold and roads are built, all paved; not well set up for trails.
 - **ACTION: Gordon and Larry to schedule a walkthrough some Friday afternoon, invite the BFTA BoD so anybody who is interested can join.**
- Didlau Trail – Larry Fariss
 - Larry met with Mrs. Didlau, who is willing to provide trail access. Judy V moved her fence; we need to grind stumps before dragging the trail. Would like to line with logs, as Larry did on his trail.
 - Would like grants of easement from Didlaus and Judy V, if possible, before starting trail work.

Ongoing Business

- Retreat at TimberRidge – Cheryl Pixley
 - EP County Attorney's office noted that Arroya Investments skipped a step: they did not create a parcel from the 4 acres. Arroya Investments needs to subdivide the 11-acre parcel before the QCD can be a legal document. EPC will not take transfer of the 4-acre parcel before it is a legal parcel. The Parcel might also need to be rezoned. The county also requires a Warranty Deed rather than a QuitClaim Deed.
 - Gordon met with Forest Gate HOA President.
 - **ACTION: Gordon to invite Forest Gate HOA President to the next BFTA BoD meeting.**
- Fox Run Friends Group – Larry Fariss
 - Has officers, a bank account, and growing membership; having an event this week.
- Pineries Open Space – Larry Fariss
 - Fence work was stopped due to freezing weather. EPC Parks will not open the site for public access until the fence is complete, probably in the Spring.

- Blocked trails – Andy Meng
 - No further discussion needed.
- Electric bicycles – Andy Meng
 - No further discussion needed.
- La Foret Bike Trail Map – Andy Meng
 - No further discussion needed.
- Meadowglen – Shoup Road connector – Gordon Limb
 - Possibly an alternative route to Section 16 along the west side of Judy V’s property.
- Black Forest Vision 2020 – Andy Meng / Gordon Limb
 - Andy and Gordon sent a BFTA writeup to Terry Stokka, who added it to the updated BF Vision 2020.
- Falcon Regional Park Equestrian Parking – Nancy Reinhardt
 - Per Judi Tobias, the \$200 we agreed to donate (on condition of the grant being approved) isn’t needed yet, but a pledge letter is wanted during the grant process.

- SAMCOM Donation – Larry Fariss
 - SAMCOM (Black Forest Slash-Mulch Committee) donated \$2500 to BFTA. To be used for signage, trail construction, and trail maintenance. Barb moved that we accept the SAMCOM donation, Diane seconded. Approved by unanimous voice vote.
